Sea Lion Island National Nature Reserve Code of Conduct

Please help us to look after the wildlife and the island by following these guidelines



Avoid any disturbance to wildlife, stay on the outside of all seabird and seal colonies

Remain at least 6 metres or 20 foot from wildlife

Do not take flash photography in close range of wildlife

Never feed or touch any wildlife

Do not startle or chase wildlife



Always give animals the right of way - do not block their routes when they are coming ashore

No animal, wild bird, egg or plant may be harmed, removed or destroyed

No disturbing, damaging or destroying the breeding site, resting place or nest of a wild animal or bird

No flying of any drones without permission of the Manager and the relevant FIG permits

No depositing of any rubbish in the Reserve (please use the designated bins inside the Lodge)

No smoking a cigarette, cigar or pipe (except within the designated area outside of the Lodge)

No lighting a fire or doing anything else likely to cause a fire

Some plants are rare or endemic, and should not be picked or uprooted

No removing artefacts, skulls, shells or biological material from the Reserve
